

## HTML Building Blocks - Lesson 2: DOCTYPE and Title Element

### Key notes to remember

1. `<!DOCTYPE>` is a browser XML element that tells the browser what version of HTML the document is.
2. `<!DOCTYPE html>` specifies the HTML 5 version of HTML.
3. DOCTYPE must be the first XML element in your page.
4. Title element is used to define a title for your page.
5. The title tag must be put in the head of the document.
6. The title is not displayed in the main window content but displayed in the Browser's Tab and Favorite's entry when the page is added to a viewer's favorites.
