

Lesson 1: Creating your base page

Key notes to remember

1. A web browser is what is used on phones and computers to surf the web. It is used to view World Wide Web documents called html pages.
2. Three technologies a web page is made up of are HTML, CSS, and JavaScript.
3. An HTML element is made up of two tags, an opening tag and a closing tag.
4. HTML elements should be written in lowercase.
5. A HTML page contains three main elements
 - a. HTML element
 - b. Head element
 - c. Body element
6. The head element is used to tell your browser particular types of metadata such the Title of the page.
7. The body element is where your main data goes that the user will see when viewing your page.
8. HTML is used to contain your data, CSS is used to style your data (present it, format it), and JavaScript is used for giving your web page behavior.
9. The title element is put in the head section of an html page.
10. The title element tells other technologies such as your browser that your page is called. If you add a web page to your favorites, this is the title that is saved there to represent your page.
11. H1 is a heading tag. It allows you to specify a section title, a heading in your document. The wording that is displayed is by default larger and bolder than the regular body wording.
12. HTML stands for HyperText Markup Language.
