

Lesson 6: Anchor and DOCTYPE

Key notes to remember

1. The DOCTYPE instruction set tells the browsers what version of HTML you are using.
2. To specify HTML 5 with DOCTYPE using the following syntax: `<!DOCTYPE html>`
3. The anchor tag is used to link to other pages.
4. The anchor tag syntax is : ` Description `
5. The href attribute tells the anchor tag what to link to. What page to go to.
6. The target attribute of the anchor tag tell the browser where to open the page. It can open in a new tab for example. HTML 5 has deprecated most of the possible values. `_blank` is still a valid option that opens a new window or tab.
